Study Abroad Testimonial: Brisbane, Australia

During the winter semester of 2009, I went to study aboard at The Queensland University of Technology (QUT) which located in heart of Brisbane city, Queensland, Australia. The time used to fly there was around 8 hours excluded hanging around in the airport during transit. Brisbane can be spotted on the map in the middle of the east coast line of Australia.

The cost of food is acceptable, just 2 times as expensive as in Thailand. There are a lot of convenient stores and supermarkets, but I recommend supermarket because everything is cheaper. Worry about cost? Let's make a profit then.

There are many places that you can work by just letting the government taxed you for 30 cents out of your hard-earned dollar. Anyway, your working hour must not exceed 20 hours a week limit. Example of typical workplace for a student; restaurants, fast-food chains, banks (for a related field), department stores, supermarkets, theatres, arcades, clubs and many more. If your head is so biz, you can open business or trade stocks under the same basis, just pay government the tax!

What can you do during your spare time? Well there are shopping malls, gaming arcades, restaurants, theatres and many more. You can choose from this list. If you are a late-nighter, the nightclub might be a great choice during Friday and Saturday nights (till dawn!). There are lots of nightclubs in Brisbane, but I suggest going to an Asian one or an Asian hosted party for your own safety. You might ask is there anything to do outside of the city? Plenty!

Outside of Brisbane, there are many great places that you should visit. Gold Coast, the beach town, is just an hour by express train. It has the most famous beach in Australia called Surfers Paradise; there are lots of places to visit and tons of activities to enjoy in the city and nearby. Out into the ocean lies the largest coral reef in the world, the Great Barrier Reef. If you are an adventurous person, you can go for a ride deep into the continent.
